



## Member Discount Program with



St. John Ambulance

ACDS and St. John Ambulance (SJA) have partnered to offer a discount program that ACDS members can make available to their staff, volunteers and individuals receiving service, as well as their immediate family.

### ACDS Members

- Staff, volunteers and individuals receiving service from ACDS Members will receive a 15% discount off of SJA published public rates on the following courses:
  - Emergency First Aid with Level A CPR and AED
  - Standard First Aid with Level C CPR and AED
  - Standard First Aid Recertification
- When registering, provide SJA with the program code **ACDS15-MEMBER** to activate the discount.
- If the associated ACDS Member is paying for registration that organization can set up a direct billing account with SJA or pay with a credit card; otherwise the registrant is responsible for payment upon registration.

### ACDS Family Members

- Immediate family members to staff, volunteers and individuals receiving service from ACDS members will receive 10% off SJA published public rates on these courses:
  - Emergency First Aid with Level A CPR and AED
  - Standard First Aid with Level C CPR and AED
  - Standard First Aid Recertification
  - First Aid in Child Care
  - What Every Babysitter Should Know
- Family members must provide SJA with the program code **ACDS10-FAMILY** to activate the discount.
- Costs to be covered by the individual upon registration.

### Additional Information

- Recertification may be an option for those who have current first aid training.
- Co-branded First Aid kit pricing is as follows:
  - 0-19 kits = retail price less 10%
  - 20-49 kits = retail price less 15%
  - 50-75 kits = retail price less \$20%
  - 76 & over = retail price less 25%
  - \$30 set up fee for less than 25 kits
  - one-time artwork fee:
    - 1 colour = \$50
    - 2 colours = \$75)
  - \$2.50/kit for logoing
- Discounts are in effect for public courses held at all SJA Alberta Council centres.
- SJA reserves the right to review training and product pricing in January each year. 30 days' notice will be given in the event of amended prices.

<b>Individual Student Cancellation</b>	St. John requires at least 2 business days notice to cancel out of the public training class	Full course refund less \$25.00 administration fee No refund with less than 2 days notice
<b>Individual Student Transfer</b>	Students may transfer to another course date up to 8:00 a.m. on the class start date	\$25.00 administration fee No refund after 8:00am
<b>Individual Student No-Show</b>	A student who does not show for class will not receive a refund on the course	No refund
<b>Private Course Cancellation</b>	St. John requires at least 2 business days notice to cancel a private training class	\$150.00 cancellation fee will apply
<b>Private Course Transfer</b>	St. John requires at least 2 business days notice to transfer a private training class	No charge with a minimum of 2 business days notice. Less than 2 business days \$150.00 fee applies
<b>Private Course No-Show</b>		Company will be charged for the class minimum number of 7 students

- Instructors must meet national standards through extensive examinations, and are required to sign an instructor agreement and provide evidence of a clear criminal record check.
- Mandatory instructor monitoring and recertification ensure instructors stay current and effective.
- Each course includes an instructor's guide, which ensures consistency of standards and content.
- At the student level, all programs require feedback in the form of student evaluation forms.
- Every graduate of a First Aid course receives a certificate with an expiration date. Each certificate is numbered and electronically recorded in a centralized national database.
