What We Offer

Foundations in Community Disability Services

A comprehensive orientation to the knowledge, skills, and attitudes essential to staff in the CDS field

Positive Behaviour Support (PBS) Training Training designed for staff

Training designed for staff supporting individuals with complex behavioural needs; a CET requirement

Non-Violent Crisis Intervention (No Holds) Training Training for staff who do not

Training for staff who do not require knowledge of restrictive interventions in their de-escalation techniques
