## **Health Assessment Screening**

## 1. Temperature screening

- The temperature of all designated visitors must be taken by a non-invasive infrared or similar device (oral thermometers must not be used).
- For reference, normal temperatures are:
  - o Ear/forehead 35.8-38.0°C (96.4-100.4°F)
- Anyone with a measured temperature of 38.0C or higher MUST NOT be admitted
  to the facility and should be advised to leave the building in order to protect the
  health of the residents.
